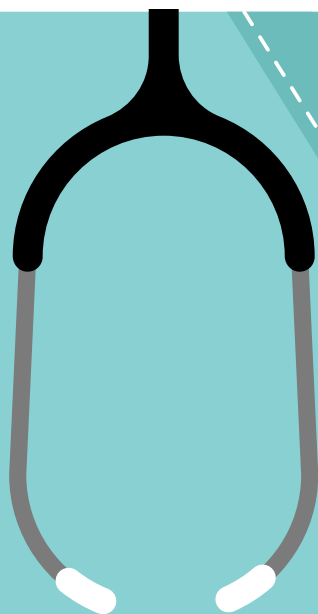

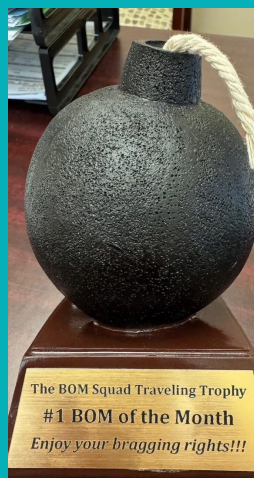
Short-Term Therapy Success

Mrs. Sandra was admitted to Treviso on March 12th after having surgical procedure on her right elbow. She required the use of a sling to help keep the joint immobilized and was non weight bearing on her right upper extremity. Upon completion of her PT and OT evaluations, she was requiring moderate levels of assist with all her bed mobility and transfers and was only able to ambulate 5 feet with handheld assist with moderate assistance and max levels of assist with all upper/lower body dressing and activities of daily life. She was able to discharge on March 28th. She was able to ambulate 400 feet with cane and only contact guard with her transfers, upper and lower body dressing and all daily living. **We are so proud of all the progress that she has made and wish her the best of luck with her continued rehabilitation.**
